Proposed to the National Priorities List

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, in conjunction with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality, has proposed the Highway 18 Ground Water site (the Site) to the National Priorities List (NPL). The NPL is the EPA's list of uncontrolled or abandoned hazardous waste sites identified for long-term cleanup under the federal Superfund program. The Site is located in Kermit, Texas. The Site is being proposed to the NPL because of the presence of contaminants in the ground water.
